Responsibility to Host Family

- Be in bed with lights out by 11 pm.

- Button down shirts (during the Bible School sessions long sleeve shirts should be worn)
- (No jeans during Bible School sessions)

For Women—

- Form-concealing dresses
- No jean skirts or split skirts
- No jewelry
- Hair put up
- Professing Christians should veil their heads

Conduct during Bible School Sessions

- Attend and participate in all classes and activities
- Cell phones should be turned off while Bible School is in session (This includes no text messaging; bring a print Bible.)
- No picture taking while classes are in session (There will be an opportunity for group photos.)
- Show proper reserve toward those of the opposite gender (Bible School is not for dating.)
