Men: Wear non-form fitting long sleeve button down shirts and dress pants (No blue jeans or cargo pants). Short sleeve shirts and blue jeans acceptable for volleyball on Saturday (No t-shirts). No jewelry.

Women: Wear loose fitting full-length dresses including a cape or double-layered blouse (No skirt and blouse) All jackets and sweaters should be open in the front (no pullovers). Hair should be worn up, with a head veiling for believers (no head bands). No jewelry or makeup.

Students are expected to attend all classes and activities. You will need permission from the principle to leave the premises or skip any sessions.
